Re: Offer of settlement of outstanding dues to ANZ Bank

We refer to your letter dated April 8, 2014.

We represent Standard Chartered Bank ("our client") and under its instructions we write to you as under:

1. We refer to your letter dated June 9, 2014 making a 'without prejudice' offer to ANZ Grindlays Bank and to subsequent correspondence and discussions with our client.
2. Our client appreciates the time spent by you on working out the proposal and also appreciate your having provided additional information regarding the availability of funds for meeting the payment to the Bank.
3. Our client remains interested in resolving this matter, if possible, by way of a settlement agreement.
4. We confirm that our client and its advisers are still considering the terms of your settlement proposal, the additional information you have provided, and the process by which a settlement of this kind could best be achieved.
